






Specialised employment websites unite job offers from a specific profession or sector. They are a useful tool both for companies, who need to recruit increasingly specialised talent, and for job searchers who want to find offers more focused on their areas of interest. These websites usually have a reduced number of jobs on offer, but they are more aligned with your professional profile and you will find less competition.

REMEMBER!

You will also find specific offers in general employment websites filtering by keyword, such as "maritime transport", "fishing", "sailing", "naval engineering", "maritime jobs" and others related to your occupation.

FOCUSING

The Blue Economy sector employs 15,806 people in Barcelona. It generates an annual turnover of more than 3.82 billion euros, which represents 4.3% of the GDP and 1.4% of employment in the city (2021).

For your self-application to succeed, you will need to send a cover letter alongside your CV and follow up on your application. Immediate results are not guaranteed, but you might be selected for unpublished offers and reduce competition to a minimum.

REMEMBER!

Companies are looking for profiles with different qualifications and value candidates with knowledge of English, experience in the maritime-fishing world, notions of maritime and international cooperation regulations and availability to work long hours.

FOCUSING

Barcelona has 16.67 km of coastline, which are a great asset in economic terms. The city has four ports (Barcelona Port, Olympic Port, Port Vell and Port Fòrum), several maritime research centres (CSIC-ICM, UPC, UAB) and a leading enterprising and innovative ecosystem.

New technologies are transforming the field of sailing. Two examples are the installation of navigation and manoeuvring systems in leisure boats and the automation and remote control of the renewable energy consumption.
